Membership Categories

Professional Membership

- **Standard Membership—**
—RNs who do not meet conditions of reduced or special membership.
- **Reduced Membership—**
—RNs who are new graduates from a basic nursing program, for first year of membership, if initiated within six months following licensure to practice as a registered nurse.
—RNs sixty-two years of age or older who are not earning more than the Social Security system allows.
- **Special Membership—**
—RNs who are not employed and are disabled under SSI/SSDI medical criteria.

Associate Membership

—Any RN not covered by an AaNA ratified contract, any member of an affiliate member organization, any LPN, any retired RN, any unemployed RN, or any student nurse.

Associate Members may participate in Committees, Taskforces, and Project Teams. Associate Members have **no voting rights** in Association business and cannot serve in any elected position on any Board, Committee, Taskforce, or Project Team.

Collective Bargaining Membership (PAMC, CPH & KGH)

—Any RN covered by an AaNA ratified contract.
